### DAY 1: WELCOME TO ICELAND & NORTHERN LIGHTS HUNT

On arrival to Keflavik International Airport, you will be greeted by a driver who will take you to your accommodation in Reykjavík. The rest of the day is free for you to settle in and explore Reykjavík at your own pace. Visit the city's many museums, galleries and landmarks or enjoy its cafés and restaurants. Central Reykjavík is also home to many bars for those interested in experiencing the city's renowned nightlife. ### DAY 2: REYKJAVIK FOOD WALK & BLUE LAGOON

Iceland can be delightful for a foodie, you just have to know where to go. Today, you will join a fun walk around Reykjavik with a local guide that has a passion for Icelandic cuisine. Get to check out Reykjavik landmarks while sampling tasty bites like homemade Icelandic ice cream, tender lamb meat, traditional Sýr and of course, a visit to the famous hot dog stand! The tour visits well-known restaurants as well as secret hangout spots that locals frequent.

In the afternoon, you have a date with the Blue Lagoon. You can spend your time bathing in the heated geothermal pool, which is rich with silica and soothing for your skin. You can also enjoy a sauna or steambath and an array of spa services (which should be booked in advance). After relaxing in the water, you can choose to dine at the luxurious Lava Restaurant at the lagoon, before transferring back to Reykjavik.

### DAY 3: THE FAMOUS GOLDEN CIRCLE & SECRET LAGOON

Today, on a personal small group tour, you will visit some of Iceland's most famous attractions along the classic "Golden Circle" route in South Iceland. One of the many highlights on this journey is Þingvellir National Park, a place of great historical and geological significance that is also listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site. Other attractions include the beautiful two-tiered Gullfoss waterfall and the spouting hot springs of Geysir, where Strokkur erupts every few minutes, gushing steam and water from the bowels of the earth.

You will also see the beautiful waterfall Faxi, before heading to the not so secret—Secret Lagoon. The beautiful surroundings and warm water is the perfect way to end the tour as you can relax, snap photos or start making plans for your night out in downtown Reykjavik.

### DAY 4: EXPERIENCE THE ICE IN ICELAND

Ready for some adventure? Today, you have the chance to get up close and personal with the icy side of Iceland. Starting from Reykjavík, you will be driven to Húsafell in the west to embark on your glacier adventure. After stops at the hot spring Deildartunguhver and the waterfalls Hraunfossar and Barnafoss, you will have a lunch break. After lunch, you will board a snowmobile and drive to the meeting spot. After climbing Langjökull glacier, you will get to go Into the Glacier before continuing your snowmobile tour back to basecamp, gliding over the icy expanse.
